
News From the Health Office

At this time of year it is a good idea to talk to children about **cold weather safety**. Extra care is needed, especially in younger children, to prevent hypothermia and frostbite.

According to the Centers for Disease Control and

Prevention, hypothermia is caused by prolonged exposure to very cold temperatures. Signs and symptoms of hypothermia include the following:

- Shivering
- Exhaustion or feeling very tired
- Confusion
- Fumbling hands
- Memory loss
- Slurred speech
- Drowsiness



- A white or grayish-yellow skin area
- Skin that feels unusually firm or waxy
- Numbness

It is important to develop an emergency plan and teach your children your emergency plan in case you are not home before the bus comes to pick them up. If a bus is delayed, your child needs to know where, when, and how to get help if they think they are waiting outside for a bus longer than they should.

Teach your child about your cold weather plan. Be sure they know:

- When to ask for help.
- Where to find safe shelter in an emergency.
- How to protect themselves with proper winter clothing and an understanding of danger signs.


