Dear Senior High School Students and Families,

I hope you enjoyed meeting and talking with our teachers during Parent-Teacher Conference day on Monday, November 25. A strong partnership between home and school is essential to our students' success in school. Rush-Henrietta teachers and administrators value our parents' insights and the support parents give to our school community. On behalf of our entire school staff, we thank you!

It is that time of year when we begin the scheduling process for the 2020-21 school year. Teachers are making course recommendations for students, which will be listed in SchoolTool as an ungraded assignment in quarter 2. Our school counselors will begin meeting with students the week of December 16, 2019, continuing through February 14, 2020. Parents are welcome to attend these important meetings, so be sure to contact your student's school counselor if you would like to come in for the meeting.



I want to remind students and their families that we will continue to participate in the Monroe One BOCES Cooperative Summer School program in 2020. This means that Rush-Henrietta students will have the opportunity to attend summer school classes, however, these classes will *not* be offered at the Senior High School. Summer school classes will be held at an as-yet-to-be-determined east side high school. Transportation from the Senior High School to that location will be provided, but students will have to get to and from the SHS on their own. We will keep you informed of details, registration, etc. as the information becomes available.

We have begun our winter concert series. You can enjoy the beautiful music our students will perform at 7 PM on Thursday, December 12, and Tuesday, December 17 in our high school auditorium. All are welcome to attend.

A reminder about the January calendar: We will be in session with classes occurring January 21-23, 2020. Regents Exams will also be administered January 21-24. We will accommodate those who have to take Regents Exams in this building while regular classes are occurring. We will communicate specifics with you if your child is taking a Regents Exam. I am glad we will be in session on these days because we need students to be in class with their teachers as much as possible. Please know we are working hard to minimize the loss of instructional time for testing purposes.



A word of caution regarding an alleged “senior skip day” during this week: *Rush-Henrietta does not promote or condone any “skip days” for any students!* These are the last days of instruction for the first semester and we would never condone or allow students to choose not to come to school. On Friday, January 24, classes will not be in session as teachers will be working to process quarter 2/semester 1 grades. All students can enjoy their time off on Friday without missing classes the rest of the week. Please mark your calendars!

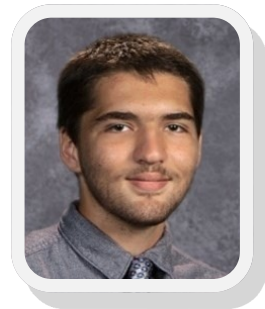

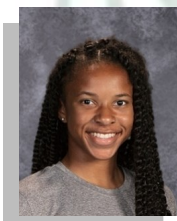

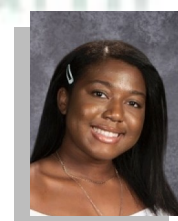

## **Natural Helpers Annual Fall Training Rush, New York**

Rush-Henrietta's Natural Helpers brushed up on mental health awareness at this Annual Fall Training.

On Friday, October 25, 70 senior high school students spent the day engrossed in a number of informative workshops dealing with issues facing teenagers on a regular basis. Safe dating, sexual assault, stress management and self-care was just a sampling of the topics these teens learned about. In the morning, they rotated through 50-minute sessions from two experts from RESTORE Sexual Assault Services, and a third presenter from SUNY Geneseo, who worked with them on taking good care of themselves through meditation and mindfulness techniques.

In the afternoon, Natural Helpers attended a Mental Health panel of six presenters (from three separate groups) who discussed their services and how to access them. Among them were 2 Rush-Henrietta alumni and an R-H faculty's son. Three students from Fairport High School represented a student-run group called, "Stop the Stigma." This group's focus is to encourage people to openly talk about concerns related to depression, mental health issues and suicide. Their hope is that through open and honest dialogue people will feel more understood and supported; and that they will be more willing to access help for their struggles. Jackson Dietz was the student leader. He is the son of Peter Dietz, a Rush-Henrietta teacher at the Webster Learning Center.

The other panel member was Lauren Udicious, a 2004 Rush-Henrietta graduate who after getting her Master's in Social Work worked for the Monroe County Child Protective Service. Lauren has since trained and become a Monroe County Sheriff, working as a road deputy and most recently as a School Resource Officer in Wheatland Chili School District. She currently serves on the Sheriff's newly established Forensic Intervention Team (FIT) which is a "first-of-its-kind". This program helps to



bring additional resources to people with mental health issues. The FIT team pairs local police officers with mental health professionals when responding to certain mental health emergencies. The program has helped to increase the number of people receiving needed mental health support, as well as decrease the number of people needing to spend time in jail or in the hospital.

The last panel member was Quan Bollar, a 2008 Rush-Henrietta graduate who works for the Center for Youth Services in Monroe County. Students and adults were highly engaged in his presentation on the resources the Center offers for youth. Quan shared a variety of helpful programs that offer support to teens and young adults in schools and in the community. These include a 24/7 Crisis Hotline, an emergency youth shelter, case management services, and a crisis nursery for parents and their infants in critical need. In addition, Quan shared fond memories of his time as a Rush-Henrietta student and lauded these Natural Helpers for the care and concern they extend to their friends and peers.

Overall, our Natural Helpers left with four hours of information providing them with enhanced skills and information to better assist their support of their school community. As one student put it, “I feel much better knowing there are so many places and people to go to when I need help with helping my friends.”

Presenters gave contact information and brochures to our students to utilize as needed.
