

# Google Drive/Classroom FAQ

How do I access my child's Google Drive from home?

1. First, have your child sign in to their [Google Account](#). ([myaccount.google.com](#)) Click the blue

sign in button  .





2. From home, you must use [@docs.rhnet.org](#)

5. If you are using a smart device, you will need to download the Google Drive  and Google Classroom  apps from the app store.

Please remember that your child's Google account is for their own educational work.

Do students use Google Drive and Google Classroom throughout Intermediate school, middle school and high school?

YES. Students will continue with the same Google Drive account.

Do files get deleted at the end of the year?

Typically at the end of the year, we have students put all their work in one folder for the year. That way it is still accessible, but "tidied up".

Is there a parent notification setting?

Yes, but it is typically not used much at the primary level because students are not using their Google Drive accounts for homework like they do in the intermediate buildings where they have the ability to take their chromebooks home.

Can I see teacher comments and grades in Drive and Classroom?

It depends. A teacher may use the comment function in Drive or they may put their comments on checklists or rubrics that they hand out to students. The same is true for grades, so check with your child's teacher.
