**The Monroe County Department of Public Health issues
Quarantine Order for K-12 unvaccinated student, teacher or staff
member exposed to COVID-19. (October 1, 2021)**



**Individual is symptom free for 10
days from their last contact with the
COVID 19 case.**

AND

**Individual is released from
quarantine by the Monroe County
Department of Public Health.**



Individual can return to school.



**While in quarantine, individual has a
temperature >100° OR has new or
unusual symptoms of COVID-19:**

- Fever, chills
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Cough
- Nasal congestion
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches



**No COVID-19 test or test
result is negative:** Individual
remains in quarantine for the
remainder of the 10 days.

**COVID-19 test result is
positive:** Individual is placed
in Isolation by the MCDPH.



**Individual is released from Quarantine or Isolation by the MCDPH.
INDIVIDUAL CAN RETURN TO SCHOOL.**
