Dear Staff, Parent and Guardians:

New York State Education Law requires that we notify building staff, parents and guardians regarding the use of herbicides or pesticides and allow you to request a 48-hour advance notice in the event we apply an herbicide or pesticide. Although we strive to minimize the use of herbicides or pesticides on school grounds, we have determined the amount of weed proliferation on some fields is potentially making them unsafe for our students. As weeds overrun the turf, the natural cushioning and traction that turf provides is lost. Furthermore, dandelions and clover are an attraction for bees, which pose an increased risk for our students with bee-sting allergies. Therefore, there will be an application on a limited number of fields between or during Memorial Day and Labor Day weekends.
