
## <u> Sudden Value Shift – Flat Sided Forms</u>

(Flat forms always have two very different values touching. One value per one side.)

- **1.On the reverse side, label the form face with a value.**
- 2. Shade the dark side first.
- **3. Outline parallel to the edges.**
- 4. Then fill. Turn your paper when needed.
- Use little parallel marks between the dotted lines.
- Shade in the direction of the arrows.
- Make each pencil stop on the dotted lines.
- Overlap each section of shading with the previous one.
- 5. Shade the light side second.

6. Shade the medium side third.



## <u> Gradual Value Shift – Rounded Form</u>

(Rounded forms are always darker on the edge and light in the middle.)



- Use little parallel marks between the dotted lines.
- Shade in the direction of the arrows.
- 1. Fill first.
- 2. Start with the dark and gradually lighten the pressure until the lightest point in the middle.
- 3. Gradually add more pressure to shift slowly back to dark at the other side.
- 4. Use shading to fill in and fix the edges.
