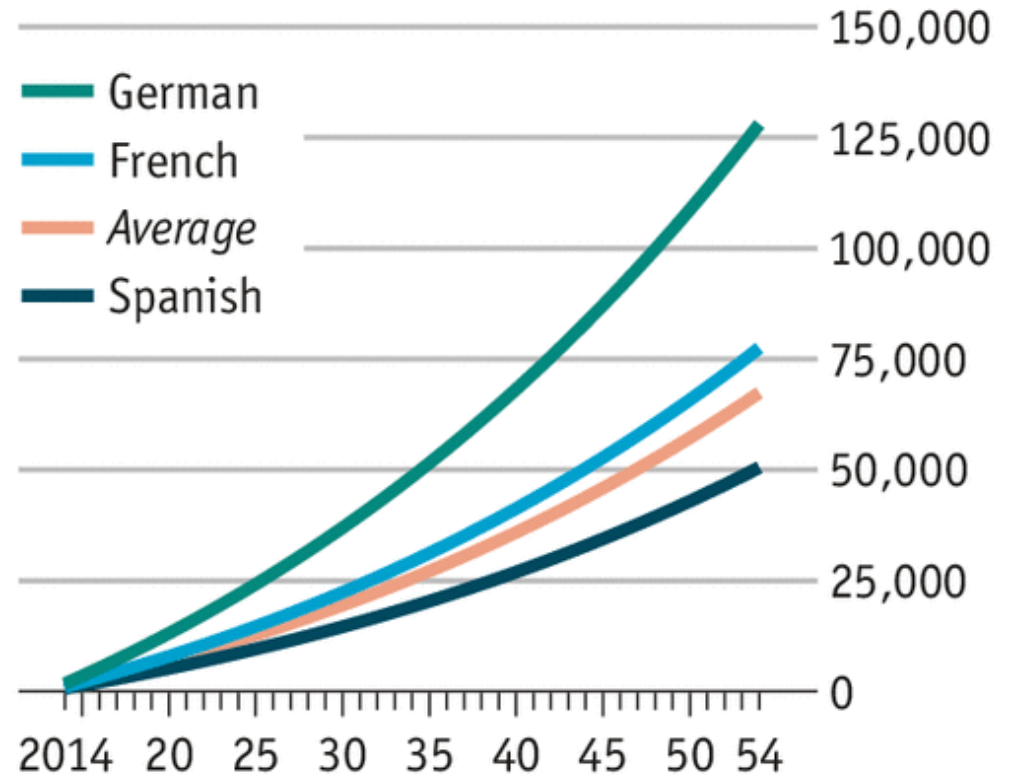

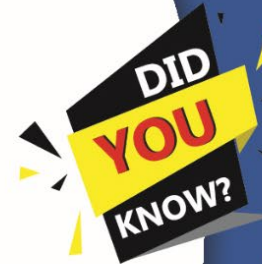
Not true, German can expand career opportunities and increase your salary.

That's \$128,000 more in lifetime earnings, far more than French (\$77K) or Spanish (\$51K).

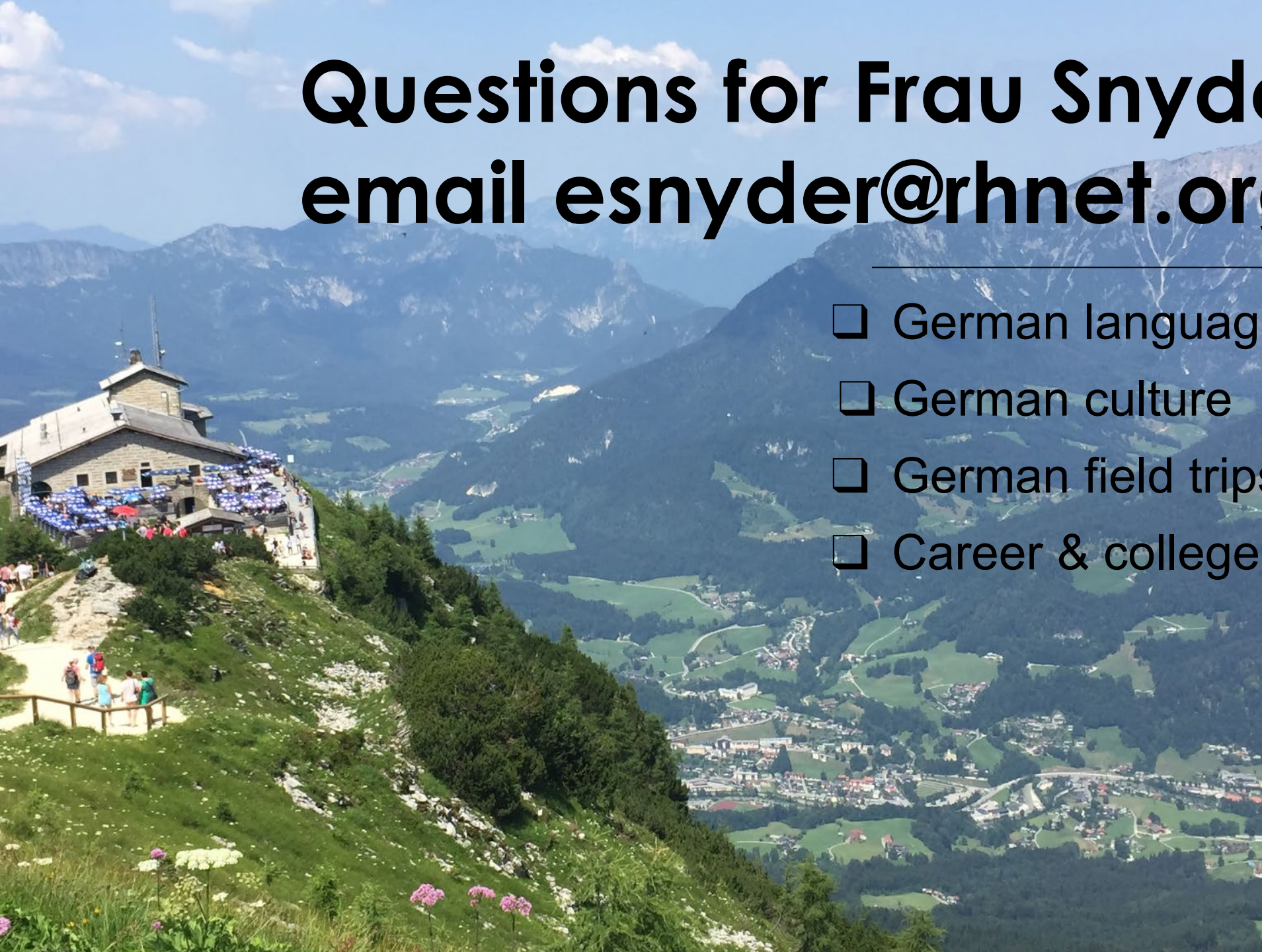
