PARENT INFORMATION REGARDING OUR SCHOOL MEALS PROGRAM



In order to feed our students safely as they return to school on September 8, 2020, and comply with New York State Education Department guidelines for reopening, we had to make a few modifications to our meals program:



••••	Paw print social distance markers have been added to the lunch lines - students must stand on the paw prints as they proceed through the lines.
*	Students must follow the one-way markers coming in and out of the serving lines.
MENU 3	The breakfast and lunch menu has been modified to offer only three entrée options. Please click on the <u>MealViewer</u> link to view menus.
	Students will pick up a complete meal from our staff at the end of the line - they will not be able to serve themselves.
SNACK?	Snacks will not be available in the K-6 schools. Limited snacks will be available at Burger, Roth, and the Senior High School. A second entrée (a la carte) will not be available as that would require the student to backtrack, which will not be allowed.
•	We are encouraging parents to prepay for meals using <u>MyPaymentsPlus</u> . We will take cash and check payments at the register, however, we cannot provide change back. Any change will be put into the student's meal account.
