Description: Jim Marventano graduated from Rush-Henrietta in 1987. He was a brilliant, warm, giving man with an aptitude for math and science. Jim’s engineering spirit led him to a career in Packaging Science. He was a gifted and avid athlete and sportsman. He loved spending time with his family, playing golf, fishing, and carpentry. Above all else, Jim was a caring and gentle soul that led by example. His grace was evident in his contact with everyone around him. Jim passed away from cancer, but not before touching the lives of several of the nurses and doctors that treated him. This scholarship will be awarded to a Rush-Henrietta student that will be making a difference in the lives of people by entering into the **medical field**.

Requirements: The Rush-Henrietta Sr. High School graduate receiving this scholarship will be selected based on the following criteria:

1. The applicant has maintained an academic record of at least an 80% cumulative average.
2. The applicant has been actively involved in at least two extracurricular activities throughout their junior and senior years.
3. The applicant demonstrates a high level of compassion and leads by example.

Applicants must also provide the information listed below:

1. Completed application.
2. A 300 word essay describing how he/she believes he/she will be an asset to the medical field and how he/she has demonstrated leadership or compassion for others.
3. A letter of recommendation from a Rush-Henrietta faculty or staff member.
