1. Applicants must be seniors graduating from Rush-Henrietta Senior High School.
2. Applicants must attach a confidential LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION in a sealed envelope.
3. Applicants must include a current RESUME.
4. Applicants must include an ESSAY addressing the requirements specific to the scholarship to which you are applying.
5. A “GREEN SHEET” (Transcript Request Form) must be submitted for transcript request or grade verification if required.
* Applicants must request an *official* copy of your high school transcript from the Counseling Center only if applying for the *Administrators Association of R-H (AARH) Leadership Award*.

Requirements:

- **Academics:** Achieving academically is an indication of student’s devotion to school, showing that education is taken seriously and understanding that there is a long-term impact. Discipline, responsibility, maturity and work ethic are all factors here when it comes to achievement and leadership.
- **Connections with others:** Positive behavior with peers indicates ability to be respectful, helpful, or assertive. A student’s social skills, attitude, and self-esteem all play a part in how they interact with fellow students, teachers and adults and demonstrate the strength of character.
- **Volunteering & community service:** Experience doing volunteer work may inspire a student to develop new skills and a greater sense of community and strength of character
- **Willingness to learn, and to learn from mistakes:** Being inspired by the act of learning and cultivating an interest in developing personal knowledge is part of leading.
- **Participation in school activities:** Engaging in school activities contributes to a positive school culture
- **Communication:** Essential to being an effective leader
