- Volunteer! Find opportunities in the CCC
- Depending on the courses you take, plan to take the PSAT in the fall or SAT Subject test in the spring – talk to your counselor for assistance

- Plan to use your summers productively; choose meaningful activities while enjoying your free time
- Think about taking classes at RIT and/or University of Rochester beginning the summer between sophomore and junior year– **tuition free!** (a benefit just for R-H juniors and seniors)
