Career Shadowing

Career Shadowing provides a unique opportunity for you to spend a day "on the job" with someone in our community employed in a career field in which you're interested. It's an exciting way to find out whether you like a specific job or career!

How can I get involved in Career Shadowing?

- ✓ Pick up a shadowing application from the CCC or download it at www.rhnet.org/cc.
- ✓ Return the completed application packet to Mrs. DeWald at least two weeks before your desired day for shadowing.
- ✓ A placement will be made and you will be provided with all the necessary details and instructions.

Career Internships

The Career Internship Program is for very responsible juniors or seniors with a strong interest in and commitment to learning about a specific career. An internship provides a focused, in-depth, hands-on work experience. Students spend about 50 hours during the course of 10-weeks, working unpaid with a professional in industry, business, or a civic organization. These practical experiences teach students job specific skills that they would not be exposed to in a purely academic setting. Internships can help students continue their learning outside the classroom, gain social responsibility, build self-esteem and increase their future college and/or employment prospects.
