PURPLE JUSTICE SCHOLARSHIP

The National Center for Missing & Exploited Children's (NCMEC/NY) mission is to help prevent child abduction and sexual exploitation; help find missing children; and assist victims of abduction and sexual exploitation, their families, and the professionals who serve them.

The tragic abduction and murder of 6-year-old Adam Walsh in 1981, as well as those of Etan Patz and Russel Mort, brought national attention to the issues faced by the families of missing children each year. Local business and community leaders, including Lou and Kathie Bivona and local child welfare agencies, responded by forming the Adam Walsh Child Resource Center in 1984. Located in Rochester, New York, the Adam Walsh Center merged with the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children in 1990 to become the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children/New York Regional Office.

NCMEC/NY is pleased to offer a <u>\$500.00</u> academic scholarship to a qualifying High school student, who is in good academic standing, entering an accredited college program with an interest in Criminal Justice.

This scholarship is named in honor of Wanda Polisseni. Mrs. Polisseni has been a longtime supporter of our local agency and true champion for children! NCMEC/NY is proud to bestow this legacy in tribute to her.

PURPLE JUSTICE AWARD

Selection of the winners will be made by the NCMEC Purple Justice Scholarship Committee. Evaluations are based on the essays, grades, community service and curriculum.

- o Students need a minimum grade point average of 2.5 to qualify for consideration.
- o Students must be graduating high school in 2017.
- O Students must submit a 500 word (or less) essay on why they wish to pursue a degree in criminal justice.
- o Applications accepted: February 8 April 30, 2017.
- o Committee selection: May 2017.
- Applications must be complete and postmarked by the due date above. No exceptions!
