## **Cafeteria**

- \*Follow procedures
- \*Walk
- \*Carry lunch tray with both hands
- \*Place trash and recycling in correct containers
- \*Clean up your area
- \*Keep your money/belongings whether offered or asked
- \*Raise hand; wait to be called

### Purpose of the Lesson/Why is it important:

1. To establish a positive, safe and caring environment in the cafeteria.
2. To practice and maintain good manners.

### Teaching Scenarios:

1. After paying for your lunch, you carry your tray with both hands and set it carefully on the table.
2. When you are finished eating, you place trash and recycling in the proper containers.
3. Before leaving the cafeteria, you double check to make sure that you have cleaned up your area on the table and picked up any trash on the floor.
4. Your friend wants to buy chips but does not have money. You have money, but you know that it is your responsibility to keep your money and belongings to yourself.
5. When you are finished eating, you raise your hand, wait to be called, and ask the cafeteria monitor to leave the table.

### Student Activities/ Role Plays:

#### Discuss/Model/Practice:

1. How to carry lunch tray with both hands.
2. How to recycle and dispose of trash.
3. The importance of keeping your area clean.
4. How to ask permission to leave your seat.
5. The importance of keeping your belongings and money for yourself

### Follow Up/Reinforcement Activities:

1. Teacher compliments the class.
2. Ask students to report others who follow the rules.
3. Staff increases rewards (STARS and tokens).
4. Pre-correct expected behaviors (Reminders before behaviors are expected).
