Important Information for College-Bound Seniors



✓ <u>College Acceptance:</u>

Once you receive an acceptance from a college or know which college you will be attending, fill out the Google sheet named 2024 College Acceptance Form in the 2024 Classroom, or email Mrs. Ottman with the exciting news. We will update your Naviance account and put a pennant on display in the cafeteria for each college to which a senior is accepted.

✓ <u>FAFSA – Student Aid:</u>

Create and complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible. This will enable your colleges to project what aid your family may receive and what the actual cost to attend will be.

✓ After You Receive Your Admission Decisions:

Notify each college or university that accepts you whether you accept or reject its offer. You should make these notifications as soon as you have made a final decision regarding the college you wish to attend, no later than May 1, 2024.

You must confirm your intention to enroll and, if required, submit a deposit to only <u>one</u> college or university. The exception to this is if you are put on a wait list by a college or university and are later admitted to that institution. You may accept the offer and send a deposit. However, you must immediately notify the college or university you previously indicated your intention to enroll.

✓ Keep applying for scholarships:
