Quick Tip:

Please feel free to send in a water bottle if your child would like to have water during the day.

Please only put water in the water bottle as we have had several leaks and the juice has spilled on other children's backpacks and school items.

We also have a fountain in class. If you send in an empty water bottle they children can fill the water bottle here and empty the bottle before we leave school to go home.
