



Helping Your Child Be Ready to Learn

- Is there a designated place at home for your child to complete homework?
- Is the place well-lit, quiet and free from distraction?
- Are school supplies (paper, pencil, crayons, glue, etc.) readily available?
- Is there a specific time each day designated for homework?
- Is there an adult available during homework time to check your child's progress and provide encouragement as needed?
- Does your child's schedule allow adequate time to complete homework?
- Do you listen to your child read his/her Take-Home Reading book each day?
- Do you check your child's Take-Home Folder daily?
- Do you remove the items from the folder's "Keep at Home?" pocket?
- Is your child's backpack organized and ready to go the night before?
- Do you monitor the time your child spends watching TV, playing video games, and using the internet for non-school related activities?
- Is there a set bedtime?
