**Hallway and Bus Loop**  
\*Stay Focus and on task  
\*Participate in learning  
\* Line up quietly, facing forward  
\*Stay in Line

**School wide Expectation: Be Ready to Learn**

**Name of the Skill: Be Ready to Learn in the Hallway and Bus Loop**

**Staff Responsible for Teaching: Classroom Teachers**

Purpose of the Lesson/Why is it important:

1. To establish a positive, safe and caring learning environment.
2. To practice what a positive, safe and caring learning environment looks like in the hallway and bus loop.

Teaching Scenarios:

1. You are walking to the bus and see a friend. You want to stop and talk to your friend but remember you should stay focused and continue to go right to your bus.
2. You are participating in your daily classroom walk in the hallway. You want to slow down and wave to a friend in a classroom you pass. You remember that both you and the other student are participating in learning and decide not to wave.
3. You are leaving a special area room. Your teacher tells you to line up at the door. You take your place in line and stand quietly facing forward with your hands at your side.
4. The fire alarm has sounded for a fire drill. You line up quietly, hands at your side, eyes forward, and walk in the line with your class.

Student Activities/ Role Plays

Discuss/Model/Practice:

1. Following directions
2. Finding and maintaining your personal bubble
3. Listening
4. Using quiet voices
5. Taking turns

Follow Up/Reinforcement Activities:

1. Teacher compliments the class.
2. Ask students to report others who follow the rules.
3. Staff increases rewards (STARS and tokens).
4. Pre-correct expected behaviors (Reminders before behaviors are expected).
5. Boosters as appropriate.
