NYSDOH Immunization survey and BMI survey have been completed for the district The District received 5472 Boxes (19 cases) of Flow Flex at-home Covid tests. These tests have an extended shelf life until October 2023. Each building was delivered one case of tests. K-6 buildings have new Violence/Sexual prevention lessons to begin in March through Monique Burr Foundation, supported by Bivona clinic relating to Erin's Law. Some Leary staff just wrapped up a district program, Mismatched: Your Brain Under Stress. Per the facilitator: "People said they liked it and tried meditation on their way to work, breathing strategies and yoga. Some even tried it with their classes when they felt overwhelmed?"
