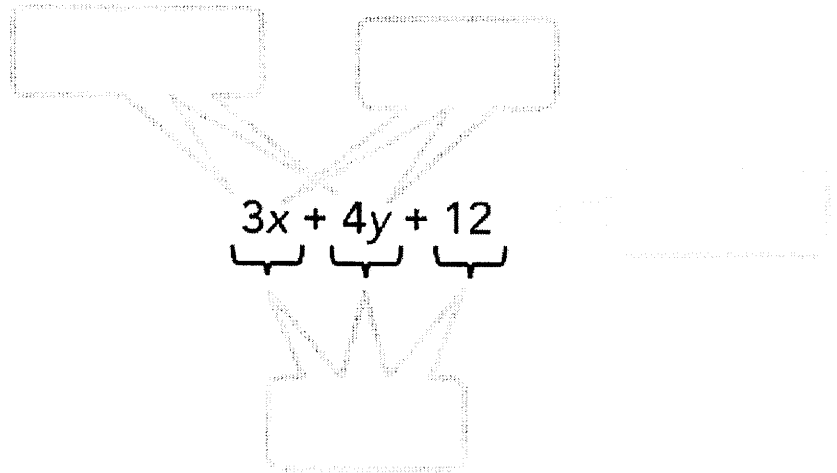

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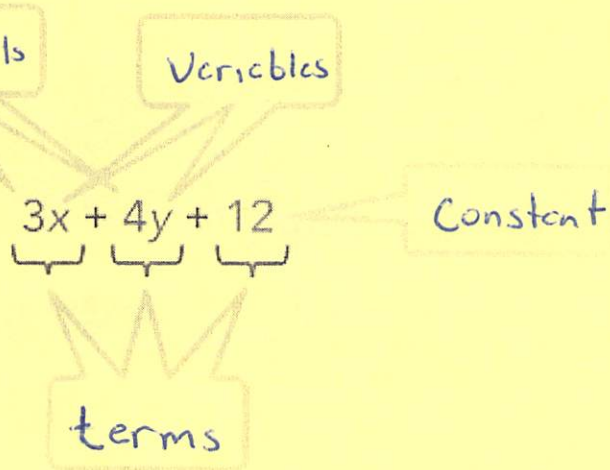
An **algebraic expression** consists of numbers, variables and operational symbols.

Variable: A letter that represents an unknown value

Term: A #, variable or the product of a # and 1 or more variables

Constant: A term that contains only numbers

Coefficient: The number in front of the variable



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
